Teaching Experience

I graduated in 2016 as the valedictorian of Dunwoody High School in Atlanta, Georgia, and attended the University of Texas at Dallas, on a full-ride scholarship as a National Merit Scholar.

Since earning a 100th-percentile MCAT score in 2019, I have helped numerous students meet and far exceed their MCAT goals. I teach the same methods I used to earn my score and tailor my sessions to target each student's weaknesses. Many of my students have performed outstandingly on the MCAT by implementing my strategies, scoring as high as 515, 517, and 520.

MCAT Tuition Approach

The first session of my MCAT classes is the same for all my students. First, we work together to build a study calendar based on students' schedules. Next, we discuss the most efficient study method that allows students to target the information they don't know. Lastly, I demonstrate my test-taking strategies as we work 1-2 passages together.

From there, any other sessions are based on the students' needs. Students send me the questions they want to discuss in our lessons, whether they are about concepts, pacing, or strategies. During the session, I present a customized set of notes addressing students' questions.
