Maths Tuition Approach

Most of my maths tuition is either focused on a particular topic that a student is struggling with or is based on a past paper that the student has completed and I have marked before the lesson. When explaining concepts to students I ask them questions to ensure they are following and that they fully understand the method. I also give them questions they have previously got wrong for them to try again: there is so much content to learn in GCSE/A Level maths so reviewing old topics regularly is really important.





Economics Tuition Approach

At GCSE and A Level, success in Economics is often down to exam technique, so I tutor in a very exam focused way. I help students to understand the criteria described in the mark scheme, and share ways of structuring essay questions to ensure that they can achieve the top marks. I also teach students how to bring in more real-world knowledge into their essays, which is particularly important at A Level.

Cambridge Economics Admissions Approach

When I was applying to Cambridge, I learnt so much about the process and what makes a successful application, I love to share this knowledge with my students. When I help students preparing for the ECAA I teach them techniques to help with the time pressure and also set them additional essays to complete to make up for the lack of past papers. For mock interviews, I have built up a bank of interview questions, many of which have been used in real Cambridge interviews.
